#### Declares :

That the course Proficiency in survival craft and rescue boats other than fast rescue boats of DHTC B.V. , the Netherlands, has been approved under course ID : PSCRB, the contents, method of instruction and the evaluation of each candidate being in accordance with the minimum requirements set out in the STCW Code.

The duration of the course is 29.5 hours on the clock spread over 4 days.
